



# CONTEMPORARY TEXTILE AWARDS

Members of the textile communities are invited to submit entries for a Contemporary Textiles Prize for which a theme is chosen for the Prize and for which there are seven categories, each with an individual monetary award.

## The six categories are:

- "Inspired by Buda" Open Section (for which the Award includes a piece of Silver)
- Embroidery of original design
- Mixed media (including patchwork and quilting)
- Working with yarn
- Wearable art
- Pigment, painted, dyed fabric

## Additional Monetary Awards will be made for the:

- Best Entry Student work, primary or junior-secondary (over fifteen is considered "Open")
- Best Entry Over-all Award.
- Visitor's choice award

## THEME

"Gold" with the exception of the Open Section "Inspired by Buda"

## VALUE OF AWARDS

\$300 prize in each category with an overall prize of \$750

## COST OF ENTRY (maximum of three per entrant)

\$15 per entry \$10 students

## EXHIBITION: JURY SELECTED DISPLAY OF ENTRIES

Not all entries received will be displayed. The top 5 entries in each category will be displayed subject to the advice of the Selection Panel and the Judges

## ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Nine members: Buda Committee Member, major sponsor representative, representatives of the local Embroiders Guild and Quilting groups and invited expert members, to meet quarterly to review progress and advise on forward planning.

## JUDGING PANEL

Three judges to be chosen on the recommendation of the Advisory Committee, from leaders in the Contemporary Textile field. (Invitations have been issued to potential judges and their names will be listed on their acceptance)

Simple description of entries by category. Funding is being sought for its publication

## APPLICATION ARRANGEMENTS AND RESTRICTIONS:

- Applicants will submit for selection by May 2010 enclosing two photos of the work- one in full and one detail and include a description of the work.
- Work must be made within two years of the exhibition
- Overall dimensions (with the exception of wearable art, maximum perimeter must not exceed a perimeter of four metres)
- Indicate the category
- Indicate status of the applicant
- Indicate whether the work is for sale. Buda will take 15% commission on sales excluding GST
- Entry fee must be paid on registration of entry
- Admit One ticket to all exhibitors to be sent with Opening invitation
